#### **NHS** Treatment

This is available at all adults and children patients. Certain categories of adult patients are exempt from charges. These include 18 year old students, pregnant women and nursing mothers within the first year, Patients who are receiving income support, family tax credit and disability working allowance recipients. All children treatment on the NHS is free.

Adults who do not fall into any of the above categories will need to pay for their treatment at fixed prices pre-determined by the NHS.

## **Private Treatment**

Bleaching, white fillings and white crowns on molar teeth are unavailable on the NHS. Our aim is to deliver high quality private care at realistic prices. Most cosmetic treatment is only available privately. Estimates will always be provided before-hand.

#### METHODS OF PAYMENT
